## Headquarters Health and Safety Assurance Report

## 1. INTRODUCTION

This report is to provide the Health and Safety Committee with an update of HQ's system for managing health and safety and to offer assurance of our compliance with health and safety matters affecting staff and visitors using its services.

The HQ facility differs from other Units in that it is managed by Orbit Facilities Management Company.

## 2. BACKGROUND

HQ Health & Safety Group is a sub-group of the Health & Safety Operational Committee. This meeting is chaired by the Head of Corporate Governance and is largely attended by Fire Wardens based within the building.

#### • Covid-19

A full risk assessment was conducted at HQ in May 2020 in relation to physical distancing. Following this assessment certain measures were undertaken in respect of social distancing and workplace safety. This was in conjunction with additional measures in relation to the fabric of the building in liaison with Orbit Facilities Management company. Signage for maximum capacity of rooms, one way systems, extra sanitiser points and screens for security were installed. Along with this, due to there being no opening windows at HQ, Orbit Facilities Management Company instructed Air Handling Units (AHU) to be set to work 24/7 with 100% fresh air supply and Fan Coil Units to work 24/7 with high speed air flow to improve the air quality within the building.

#### • Incidents

There have been 0 incidents reported at HQ during 2020/21.
