

 Reduction in overall PTL volumes for all tumour sites (15%)

- Biggest improvement in Colorectal and Breast (59% & 42%)
- Gynaecology now of concern with 48% increase in PTL volume







Split of Current PTL by Tumour Site

Backlog Removal









Trajectories 23/24

Main Areas of Concern and Mitigating Actions:

CEO has met with MDT leads in the following services and agreed:

- Gynaecology pathway:
 - increased capacity for Post Menopausal Bleed (PMB) clinics and Hysteroscopy
 - Regional working with Hywel Dda to increase capacity for surgery
- Colorectal Operating at Morriston Hospital
 - Increased capacity at Singleton to minimise need for Morriston
 - 3 session days at Morriston to increase capacity
- Urology
 - Increased capacity at front end of the pathway to achieve decision to treat (DDT) by day 31
 - Increase capacity for robotic surgery at UHW
 - Innovation within Pathology service to increase turn-around times on samples
- Head & Neck
 - Increase outpatient capacity in OMFS clinics to achieve decision to treat (DDT) by day 31
