Name of Group:	Children and Young People's Continuing Care Forum Peer Review session
Purpose:	<p>The main purpose of the group is to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Develop and agree a national peer review process for Children and Young People's Continuing Care Guidance 2020. This will allow for specific Health Boards to adapt to meet local pathways whilst maintaining the principles of the guidance. • Enable Children's Continuing Care Nurse assessors to obtain advice and support in relation to assessments that have resulted in dispute from the Multidisciplinary team and / or children, young people and their families. • To provide an impartial objective recommendation of eligibility for CYP continuing care • Enable peer review so that disputes are resolved as quickly as possible. To ensure recommendations in relation to the most complex CC cases are fair and equitable on an All Wales basis. • <i>Ensure local sign off through Health Boards Governance</i> • To facilitate LHBs and LAs to have dispute resolution built into their agreed continuing care pathway • To advise the All Wales CYP Continuing Care Forum of themes in relation to dispute and provide feedback to welsh Government where appropriate for re occurring themes.
