# DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC HEALTH ANNUAL REPORT 2018 HEALTHY SEXUALITY – WELLBEING IN SEX AND RELATIONSHIPS

#### 1. INTRODUCTION

There is a statutory duty on the Director of Public Health to produce an Annual Report on the health of the local population. This report may focus on a particular issue or topic. The report represents an independent professional view of a local public health issue and is provided as a steer for local action.

The 2018 DPH annual report focuses on the sexual health and wellbeing of our population in Swansea, Neath Port Talbot (NPT) and Bridgend.

The version presented to Board is pdf format, for ease of presentation. However, the report is published as an 'e-book'.

### 2. BACKGROUND

This DPH Annual Report was written in response to the 2018 national review of sexual health services undertaken by Public Health Wales. The review made 9 recommendations for improvement in sexual health services in Health Board areas in Wales. The annual report was intended to provide an overview of local need for sexual health services and local service provision and to identify gaps in provision. This information will support the health board in preparing to respond to the service review and any Welsh Government directives arising from it.

Since the annual report was completed, Welsh Government published a Health Circular on 5<sup>th</sup> March 2019 (*Implementing recommendations of the review of sexual health services – action to date and next steps* WHC/2019/011). The circular requires Health Boards to undertake an audit of local sexual health services provision and create a local improvement plan in response, by June 2019.

The recommendations contained within the DPH Annual Report are in line with the policy position expressed in the Health Circular
