I refer to your Freedom of Information Act Request acknowledged by ourselves on 17th April 2019. We apologise for the delay in responding. You clarified on 3rd May 2019 that the two letters you had sent us referred to the same question in relation to the Amman Tawe Partnership.

Please disclose the historical information that the Board holds on the quality of the service already provided that allows it and/or the Amman Tawe Partnership to make a prophecy that closing Cwmllynfell Surgery will enable the Amman Tawe Partnership to delivery 'first class health services'? Please will you disclose a reasonable body of information which your Board holds which supports a proposition that the Amman Tawe Partnership provides 'first class health services?'

In 2017 a clinical review of the Amman Tawe Partnership model was commissioned by both Swansea Bay University Health Board (formally Abertawe Bro Morgannwg) and Hywel Dda University Health Board. This review is currently awaiting formal approval from both Health Boards but has demonstrated good access to GMS care delivery. As a result we are unable to provide a copy. This is in line with Section 22 of the Freedom of Information Act which states that information is exempt if it is intended that the information held by the public authority will be published at a future date. This document should be available in Autumn 2019.

Please note that contractual and quality monitoring is ongoing agenda for Swansea Bay University Health Board and aspects of the contract are monitored through a variety of markers, including the All Wales Clinical Governance Practice Self-Assessment Tool,
