I refer to your Freedom of Information Act Request acknowledged by ourselves on 22<sup>nd</sup> May 2019. Your request sought information relating to eye conditions.

Please note that from 1<sup>st</sup> April 2019 responsibility for providing healthcare services for people in the Bridgend County Borough Council area transferred from Abertawe Bro Morgannwg University Health Board to Cwm Taf Morgannwg University Health Board. In light of this change to ABMU's responsibilities, the organisation's name has changed to Swansea Bay University Health Board. However as this response was for information prior to April 2019, we have provided the information that ABMU Health Board held which will include Bridgend data.

**Within your Health Board how many Intra-vitreous Injections / Implants have been used in the latest 4 months, if possible between January and April 2019. If your Health Board is able to identify Injections / Implants by eye conditions please split by the drug used (Ranibizumab, Bevacizumab, Aflibercept, Fluocinolone and Dexamethasone).**

To obtain this information by condition would involve a manual trawl of patient records which we have estimated would significantly exceed the 18 hours limit set down by the FOI Act as the reasonable limit. Section 12 of the FOI Act provides that we are not obliged to spend in excess of 18 hours in any sixty day period locating, retrieving and identifying information in order to deal with a request for information and therefore we are withholding this information at this time.

\* Where fewer than 5 has been indicated we are unable to provide you with the exact number of patients as due to the low numbers, there is a potential risk of identifying individuals if this was disclosed. We are therefore withholding this detail under Section 40(2) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000. This information is protected by the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and Data Protection Act 2018 and its disclosure would be contrary to the data protection principles and constitute as unfair and unlawful processing in regard to Articles 5, 6, and 9 of GDPR. This exemption is absolute and therefore there is no requirement to apply the public interest test.
