I refer to your Freedom of Information Act Request acknowledged by ourselves on 6th November 2019. Your request sought information relating to hygiene training.

Please provide me with your training curriculum regarding hygiene, in terms of - duration of training, in-depth and specificity of the training, whether there is any mandatory or non-mandatory training every year or every three years etc; for nurses, healthcare workers (new or experienced), volunteers and formal/informal carers potentially.

Training delivered by the Infection Prevention & Control Team.

Hand decontamination

This training is mandatory for all staff in a clinical setting and is renewed regularly/annually according to the individual's role. It is delivered face to face. All clinical areas have designated Hand Hygiene Coaches who are available and able to provide regular/annual training to staff. This takes approximately 1 hour to deliver and includes:

- A presentation including theoretical background & the organisations expectations.
- A video demonstrating the correct technique,
- Discussions around applying the principles of the World Health Organisation "My 5 Moments" for hand hygiene at the point of care delivery,
- A practical session using UV florescent products to check their hand washing technique.

Standard Infection Control Precaution

This is part of the All Wales mandatory training for all Health Board staff and must be renewed every 3 years.

There are 2 training levels available according to role; clinical or non-clinical. This is delivered via an e-learning platform on ESR. It can also be supplemented by an option to attend an hour long, face to face update using a presentation on SICP. Training includes:

- Patient Placement
- Hand hygiene (& annual updates with practical session)
- Respiratory Hygiene and Cough Etiquette
- Safe use of PPE
- Management of Care Equipment
- Control of the Environment
- Safe Management of Linen
- Safe management of Blood & Body Fluids
- Safe Waste Disposal
- Occupational Exposure Management including sharps safety
- Asepsis (plus additional e-learning & assessor training this takes approximately 1 hour each & includes a competency assessment. This is 3 yearly and is role specific.)


