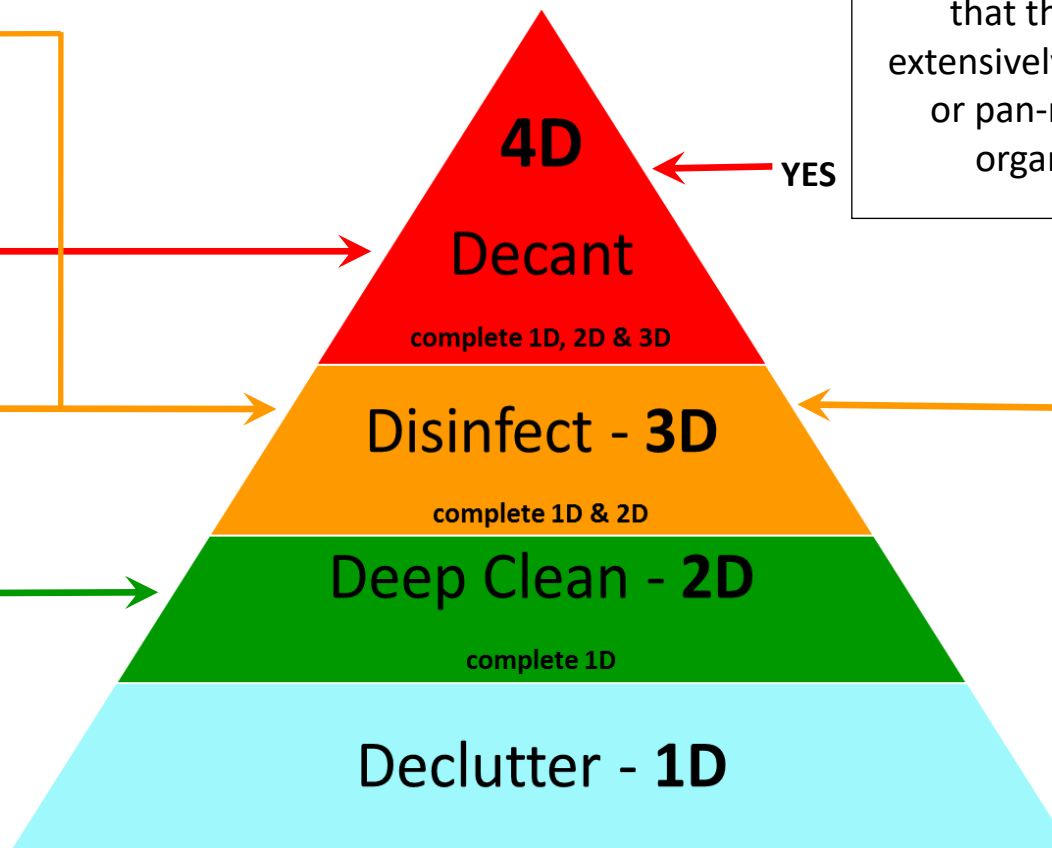

4D — for significant infections, such as *Clostridium difficile* or Carbapenemase producing organisms, it is preferable for the 4D process to involve decanting of patients to facilitate the utilisation of Ultraviolet-C (UV-C) decontamination. Hydrogen Peroxide Vapour (HPV) decontamination will be utilised only if considered by, and on the approval of, the Health Board Outbreak/Incident Control Group.
