1. Do you use Hydrogen Peroxide Vapour (HPV Fogging) or Ultraviolet (UVC) for decontamination?

HPV Fogging is not currently in use at Swansea Bay University Health Board. Ultraviolet decontamination is in use in two of our three acute sites. It will be introduced into our third acute site in January 2020.

- **2. What company/system do you use and how many?** We own 4 Gama UVC machines and have 1 as a trial from GAMA.
