I refer to your Freedom of Information Act Request acknowledged by ourselves on 14th August 2020. Your request sought information relating to travel expenses.

Please include the information for each of the following periods: 2019-20; and April 2020 to the present day:

- The total cost of travel expenses for staff including travel by flight, train and car.

General travel expenses 2019-20 = £2,818,133.74

2020-21 (Apr-July) = £647,877.32

Travel for training purposes 2019-20 = £95,445.34

2020-21 (Apr-July) = £0.00

- The details of the top three most expensive trips, including their cost, mode of travel as well as arrival and departure destinations.

This information is not held centrally. To obtain this information would involve a manual trawl and search of invoices which we have estimated would significantly exceed the 18 hours limit set down by the FOI Act as the reasonable limit. Section 12 of the FOI Act provides that we are not obliged to spend in excess of 18 hours in any sixty day period locating, retrieving and identifying information in order to
