## **3.** How many of these patients were admitted for social care reasons in that they could not administer their own eye drops?

The Health Board would not hold this information centrally. The information would be held in patient records, therefore to obtain this information would involve a manual trawl and search of records which we have estimated would significantly exceed the 18 hours limit set down by the FOI Act as the reasonable limit. Section 12 of the FOI Act provides that we are not obliged to spend in excess of 18 hours in any sixty day period locating, retrieving and identifying information in order to deal with a request for information and therefore we are withholding this information at this time.
