

Please note that the Health Board is carrying out significant work around recruitment generally and has a dedicated area on its website for recruitment: https://sbuhb.nhs.wales/jobs/jobs-and-volunteering/. Within this area of the website the Health Board has details of vacancies, up-coming recruitment days, contact information and short videos (developed in-house) advertising the benefits of working for SBU and interviews with staff. As well as emphasising the career and learning opportunities offered by being part of such a large NHS organisation, we actively promote the great work-life balance that living in Swansea and South West Wales offers, including affordable housing, our beaches, countryside, etc.

Much of our nurse recruitment campaigning is done through targeted social media campaigning, which has resulted in a number of experienced nurses joining us from other parts of the UK.
