I refer to your Freedom of Information Act Request acknowledged by ourselves on 19th April 2021. Your request sought information relating to Insourcing.

You clarified on the 13th May that when referring to insourcing – this is not to be confused with outsourcing or agency. Insourcing is where a third-party provider of secondary care uses an NHS organisation’s premises and equipment to deliver extra clinical capacity, outside of when they are normally in use. In most cases it is essentially an extension of a hospital’s existing clinical service. This would be with particular focus on Planned Elective Care.

1. How much has been spent on which insourcing provider in the last 3 years. In the most recent FY in the 12 months ending March 2021 split by month.

Medinet was the provider used to November 2019.
ID Medical was the provider used from December 2019 onwards.
