I refer to your Freedom of Information Act Request acknowledged by ourselves on 4th June 2021. Your request sought information relating to international recruitment.

1. International recruitment budget (If not an allocated budget, under which cost centre would the budget sit?)

The Health Board does not have a specific international recruitment budget.

Doctors/Medical staff would sit under the Workforce and Organisational Development budget, whilst Nursing recruitment would sit under the Director of Nursing Budget.

AHP/HSS – is not applicable. Swansea Bay are not recruiting internationally for this staff group at present.

This information has been withheld. Section 43 of the Act sets out an exemption for the right to know if release of the information is likely to prejudice the commercial interests of any person (a person may be an individual, a company, the public authority itself or any other legal entity). Section 43 is a qualified exemption. That is, it is subject to the public interest test.

Whilst the Health Board accepts that there is a public interest in ensuring openness and transparency and there is an interest in the public being aware of how much money is spent and the benefits derived from that expenditure. The Health Board believes that disclosure of information in a manner which fails to protect the interests and relationships arising in a commercial context could have the effect of discouraging companies from dealing with the Health Board because of fears that the disclosure of information could damage them commercially. In turn this could then jeopardise the Health Boards ability to compete fairly and pursue its function to bring forward development in the area and obtain value for money. It is therefore decided that it is not in the publics' interest to disclose this information.

However we can inform you that it is a condition of any overseas recruitment that recruits agree to pay a percentage of the relocation package upon leaving based on a sliding scale.
