To help us minimise the risk of infection, we use Clinell Chlorhexidine Wash Cloths for patient bed bathing. These contain 2% chlorhexidine and have been clinically proven to reduce the number of harmful bacteria that can live on our skin, making them more effective than soap and water alone.










We have also reviewed our environmental impact by introducing this product. Without compromising on patient care,

with one pack of cloths, we have significantly reduced the amount of waste generated. Traditional methods involve using wash bowls, soaps, lotion and laundering towels.

Initially your skin may feel sticky, this is just the chlorhexidine creating a protective barrier on your skin and won't last long. They can be used at room temperature or heated for a warm bed bath. Due to the antiseptic nature of the cloths, they are for external use only.

Directions for use

Following the steps below, wipe all areas of your body thoroughly to ensure maximum protection. Discard wipes after use. Do not use on mucosal membranes. Let your body air dry. If you are unable to use the wipes yourself, please let one of the nursing staff know and they will assist you.

WIPE 1: Chest & neck 	WIPE 2: Back 	WIPE 3: Left arm & armpit 
WIPE 4: Right arm & armpit 	WIPE 5: Right leg 	WIPE 6: Left leg 
WIPE 7: Groin 	WIPE 8: Buttocks
