This initial "severity" level is subject to interpretation by the individual submitting the incident/inputting the data.

These severity levels are not necessarily reflective of the final outcome of each incident, as they have not yet been investigated and closed. Please be aware that these numbers are indicative only, and could change.

You asked:

 Please could you tell us how many incidents were logged relating to staffing issues in the years 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021 and 2022 (to date). The category on the Datix system for this is, we understand, "staffing/inappropriate skills mix" although this may differ between trusts. Please could you break these down by degree of harm (i.e. No harm, low, moderate, severe, death) as set out in the table below.
