## You asked:

1. How many patients have been treated for glioblastoma brain cancer in the last 12 months, in your health board?
There were 31 patients with admitting diagnosis of Glioblastoma brain cancer between $1^{\text {st }}$ April 2021 to $31^{\text {st }}$ March 2022. Please note that the number of patients seen with Glioblastoma may be more than those admitted.
2. Which consultant is the nominated medical lead for the treatment or referral of glioblastoma brain cancer?
The Health Board does not have a nominated lead, however we can tell you that treating patients lies with the Neurosurgeons, Professor Roger Taylor for Chemotherapy and palliative care for terminal cases.
3. Does your health board treat all referred glioblastoma brain cancer cases, or are they referred to different centre's? If so, which treatment centre(s) are they referred to?
Yes, Swansea Bay Health Board treats glioblastoma brain cancer cases, however some may also be treated at University Hospital of Wales and Velindre NHS Trust.
