For information in relation to fertility treatment for transgender patients.

1. Which of these fertility treatments do you provide for your transgender patients?

- **Egg harvesting** - Yes
- **Cryopreservation of eggs** - Yes
(a) How long do you offer cryopreservation of eggs for? - 55 years
- **Extraction of sperm, both surgical and self-ejaculatory**
Yes (Surgical Sperm Removal, if medically required)
- **Cryopreservation of sperm** Yes
(a) How long do you offer cryopreservation of sperm for? - 55 years
- **IVF Embryo Treatment** - Yes, if patients meet Welsh Health Specialised Services Committee (WHSSC)* eligibility criteria for IVF
- **Embryo cryopreservation** - Yes
(a) How long do you offer embryo cryopreservation for? - 55 years
- **Ovarian Tissue Extraction and Cryopreservation** - Not currently offered by the Wales Fertility Institute (WFI) but referral can be made to specialist centre
(a) How long do you offer cryopreservation of ovarian tissue for? - Not applicable

2. What, if any, are the youngest ages of patients that are entitled to receive these treatments?

- **Egg harvesting patient** >16 years old
- **Egg cryopreservation** - as above
- **Sperm harvesting** - children who are going through puberty and are likely to be able to produce sperm



- **Sperm cryopreservation** - as above
- **IVF Embryo Treatment** – age 20 and eligible for IVF
- **Embryo cryopreservation** - age 20 and eligible for IVF
- **Ovarian Tissue Extraction and Cryopreservation**
Not currently offered by the Wales Fertility Institute (WFI), however referral can be made to specialist centre
