You asked:

1. How many Covid-19 Patient Safety Incident (PSI) investigations have been fully completed so far?

679 cases are currently under investigation by the nosocomial review team within the Health Board. Currently, 15 cases are considered complete with the rest progressing through set Welsh Government processes and quality assurance checks including feedback and learning outcomes to clinical and managerial teams. These cases are at different stages but the expectation is the majority will move to complete over the next six weeks which includes responses to next of kin / designated legal representative.

- 2. How many PSI investigations are currently active and not yet completed? 664
- 3. How many PSI investigations does the HB estimate still need to be started? 2,782
- 4. How many Covid-19 PSI investigations relating to nosocomial infections were triggered by a complaint by a patient or related family member?

 Nosocomial COVID-19 investigations are triggered by patients having contracted COVID-19 through the delivery of NHS-funded care. These cases will be investigated whether a complaint has been made, or not.
- 5. How many covid-19 PSI investigations have resulted in an offer of redress, in the form of financial compensation?
 None, based on reviews completed, to date.
- 6. Please can you tell me if anonymised information gathered from these investigations will be published so that the public can see the results of this learning? If so, when do you intend to do this and what form is it likely to take?
