You asked:

In the Bonymaen Ward, Swansea there are proposals for two housing schemes which would amount to nearly 200 housing units. Much of this would be family accommodation. The schemes are a) 160 houses in the Brokesby Road area b) 30 houses on Pentrechwyth Road.

These are both based in the Lower Super Output Area of Bonymaen 1 recognised as being in the top 10% of areas of deprivation in Swansea and Wales.

I have been trying to find out what additional public sector facilities would be recommended and put in place should these proposals be enacted.

a. What additional provision would be recommended to enable local surgeries (including GP, health visitors, midwives) to cope with the additional population?

This information is not recorded by the Health Board.
