- Forensic community services
- Outpatient services
- South Wales Police and MAPPA (multi agency public protection arrangements) liaison services
- Gate keeping and case monitoring services on behalf of WHSSC (Welsh Health Specialised Services Committee) for patients in independent sector or deemed to require medium security. Case monitoring included high secure services.
- Forensic psychiatric liaison to health boards.

Therefore, any inpatient incidents that occur for patients from outside the SBUHB boundary under the care of our forensic mental health services would be attributed to SBUHB. Please bear this in mind when reviewing the numbers below.
