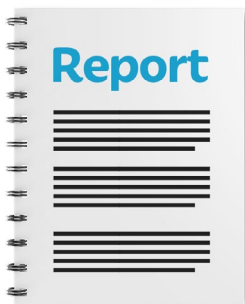
How we will use your information
