On Admission to Ward M you will need for your baby

- Babies bottles/teats
- Baby milk
- Lightweight clothes as ward environment is hot. If baby is having lip repair, try to avoid clothes that need to be pulled over the babies head to avoid catching the lip
- Personal items to make their stay comfortable
- Nappies
- Hygiene items (washing products, towel)
- Car seat
- Breast pump if needed
- Medication

Provided

- Cot and linen
- Steriliser , fluid is changed daily by staff
- Toys
- Limited Baby Jars...bring your own favourites
- Fridge/freezer for storage (label everything)

For yourself

- Cool clothing and light footwear
- Tea/Coffee
- Food which can be stored in fridge in patients room or dried food you can keep in room e.g. snacks, crisps, biscuits

General Information

- There is room for one to stay with baby/child on ward. There is also limited accommodation in hospital for a second relative to stay. This can only be requested on day of admission and CANNOT be guaranteed.
- Open visiting on ward for parents and between 2 and 7 for other family members.
- Only 2 at bedside in the High Dependency Unit (on the day of surgery).
- Canteen opening:

Breakfast	7.45am-10.45am
Lunch	12.00pm-2.00pm
Supper	6.00pm-7.30pm
Late Supper	8.00pm-10.00pm
- Coffee shop open 10.45am until 3-4.30pm
- Vending machines available for snacks and drinks. Shops available in the main entrance for sandwiches, drinks, magazines etc.
- Bring change for vending machines.
- Mobile phones not to be used around medical equipment.
- Hot drinks **only** to be drunk in parents room and **not on the ward.**
- Admission 10:00am day prior to surgery to secure bed and have preparation for surgery.
